**A Judicial Review** of the approval of Laver Leisure application for 250 Lodges will be heard on **20th July** in Manchester. Meanwhile **Laver Leisure** have lodged an appeal against the refusal decision concerning the 'no right turn' and the original refusal of the 250 'cabins' at Moneystone Quarry with details of the approved application included. This should be heard at SMDC offices in Leek late October-November.

**Whiston Hall Golf Club** have made 2 applications to SCC requesting an EIA screening for the importation of between 225,000 and 300,000 tons of inert material for the remodelling of the course to facilitate use by disabled golfers. Access will be from Blakely Lane and involve 40-50 deliveries per day between 8am and 7pm spread over a period of 40 weeks.
