The Judicial Review of the approval of Laver Leisure application for 250 Lodges was heard on **20th July** in Manchester and the Judge found in favour of the Council. The **Laver Leisure** appeal against the refusal decision concerning the 'no right turn' and the original refusal of the 250 'cabins' at Moneystone Quarry will be heard in the Churnet Room, SMDC Offices, Leek from 10 am on 7th November, lasting for 7 days, not consecutively. Anybody who wishes to speak may do so but must register their wish to do so on the first day.
